# A Way In A Manger

## **Text:** Luke 2:7-14

# Introduction:

- 1. The importance of Jesus' birth is that it was the beginning of the culmination of God's scheme of redemption.
  - a. Yet, it is not the birth of Jesus that is to be honored and celebrated; rather, it is what being born as a man allowed Jesus to accomplish.
  - b. We are commanded to remember His death and worship God by the memorial of His suffering at Calvary.
- 2. Jesus was born to bring to fruition God's means of saving man.
- 3. By His life and death, Jesus provided a way of salvation a way to Heaven.
- 4. Thus, when He was born there was "a way" in a manger...

# I. A High Way

- A. Isaiah 35:8-10
- B. The word "highway" refers to a road that has been elevated or mounded up above the ground (thus, a high way).
- C. Consider the high way of God...
  - 1. It is high exalted above all other ways.
  - 2. It is named "The Way of Holiness."
  - 3. The unclean do not have access to it.
  - 4. It is exclusively for God's people.
  - 5. Even the unlearned can follow this path.
  - 6. There is no danger on this road.
  - 7. The destination of this road is Zion.
  - 8. Joy, gladness and the absence of sorrow are the rewards.
- D. The Way of God is in every way higher than the ways of man!
- E. That Way of God was brought by the One laid in a manger.

### II. A Straight Way

- A. It is straight for all obstacles are removed (Matthew 3:3; Luke 3:3-6).
- B. It is straight for is founded upon the Word of God (Acts 24:14, 22).
- C. It is straight for it goes against the majority (Matthew 7:13-14).
- D. It is straight for it demands faithful discipline (2 Peter 2:20-22).

### III. A Safe Way

- A. Not of man's design (Proverbs 14:12).
- B. Not free from suffering (Acts 9:1-2; 22:4; 19:9, 23).
- C. Jesus is the way (John 14:6).

- 1. The way of love (1 Corinthians 12:31).
- 2. The way of peace (Romans 3:17; Ephesians 2:15).
- 3. The way of hope (Acts 24:14-15).
- 4. The way of salvation (Luke 1:76-79).
- 5. The way to Heaven (Hebrews 9:7-12; 10:19-20; John 14:4-6).

## Conclusion:

- 1. While Jesus' birth is important, it is to His life, His teaching, His death and His resurrection we must give the most attention.
- 2. By His life and death, Jesus brought to man the knowledge of the Way of God.
