Evidences of Abiding in Christ

Introduction:

- 1. To abide with Christ in Heaven, one must first abide in Him here.
- 2. John teaches us that we can know that we are in Him (1 John 2:5).
- What are the evidences of abiding in Christ? 3.
- Ι. Keeping God's Commandments (1 John 3:19-24)
 - Knowledge of obedience is stronger than any feeling. Α.
 - To keep His commandments is to do those things that please Him. Β.
 - Believe the authority of Jesus 1.
 - 2. Love one another
 - C. Notice the connection between the commands and the Spirit.
- II. Walking as Christ Walked
 - Α. We tend to imitate those with whom we are closest.
 - B. As Christians, abiding in Christ means we strive to imitate Him (cf. 1:7; Matthew 11:28-30; John 13:15; 1 Corinthians 11:1; 1 Peter 2:21).
- III. **Not Practicing Sin**
 - The hope of eternal life motivates us to purify ourselves. Α.
 - Β. This means removing the habitual practice of sin from our lives.
 - C. Daily, we strive to stop transgressing the law of God.
 - D. If we allow God's word to remain in our hearts, we cannot allow sinful practices to dominate our lives.
- IV. Loving One Another (1 John 4:7-16)
 - We must love one another, because God is love. Α.
 - By loving one another, we make the invisible God seen in the world. Β.
 - C. By living lives of this kind of love, we continue to confess Christ.
- V. **Bearing Fruit**
 - Those who abide in Christ bring forth much fruit. Α.
 - If we do not bear fruit, we risk being cut off forever. Β.
- VI. Remaining Faithful to God's Word (1 John 2:21-25; 2 John 9)
 - Α. God's truth can be known.
 - By abiding in it, we also abide in the Father and the Son. Β.
 - C. Thus, we have God's faithful promise – eternal life.
