THE BRIDE OF CHRIST

Introduction:

- 1. The New Testament uses many terms and concepts to describe the church of Christ.
- 2. As members of the church, it is important for us to know what the church is and what the Lord expects it to be.
- 3. Thus, as we study these divine descriptions of the church, we will learn how we are to conduct ourselves individually and as a congregation of God's people.
- 4. The role of the church in God's plan of redemption...
 - a. Eternal purpose
 - b. Connected to the crucifixion
 - c. Result of the resurrection
 - d. Established on Pentecost
- 5. Descriptive Designations of the Church:
 - a. "The Called Out"

- I. The Beauty of the Bride

(2 Corinthians 11:2)

- A. The church is described as the bride of Christ.
 - 1. "He that hath the bride is the bridegroom" (John 3:29).
 - 2. Those who become Christians are betrothed/married to Christ (Rom. 7:1-4).
 - a. Note that this did not take place until after the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus.
 - b. Note that this demonstrates the change from physical Israel to spiritual Israel as the people of God.
- B. The church is a beautiful bride when it is pure (cf. Song of Solomon).
 - 1. Pure in doctrine (2 Corinthians 11:2-4)
 - 2. Pure from sin (Ephesians 5:25-27)
- C. Thus, a beautiful relationship exists between Christ and His church.
- II. The Blessings of the Bride

(Ephesians 5:22-33)

- A. The church is the only bride of Christ (Eph. 5:22-23).
 - 1. One husband Jesus
 - 2. One wife the church
 - 3. Marriage to many churches would be spiritual polygamy!
- B. The church wears the name of Christ (Matt. 16:18; Isa. 56:5; 62:1-2; 65:15; Acts 11:26; 20:28).
- C. The church is loved greatly by Christ (Eph. 5:25-33).
- D. The church is joined eternally to Christ (1 Cor. 15:24; 1 Thes. 4:17).
- E. The church is saved by Christ (Eph. 5:23).
- F. The church bears fruit for Christ (Rom. 7:4; cf. John 15:1ff).
- III. The Faithfulness of the Bride

(Matthew 19:6)

- A. The church is faithful when obedient (Heb. 5:8-9; Matt. 7:21).
- B. The church is faithful when loyal to Truth.
- C. The church is faithful when pure from sin. (Cf. Jer. 3; 23)
