Introduction:

- 1. The New Testament uses many terms and concepts to describe the church of Christ.
- 2. As members of the church, it is important for us to know what the church is and what the Lord expects it to be.
- 3. Thus, as we study these divine descriptions of the church, we will learn how we are to conduct ourselves individually and as a congregation of God's people.

- I. Who Are the Saved?

(Ephesians 5:23)

- A. The religious world has a different view of salvation than that taught in the Bible.
 - 1. They see and teach two processes or, a two-fold process.
 - 2. First, one is saved from sin by faith in Jesus.
 - 3. Then, the one saved joins the church of his or her choice.
- B. The Bible teaches that all of the saved are in the church and, the church is the only sphere wherein the saved are located (Eph. 1:22-23; 4:4; 5:23).
 - 1. Consider the previously noted descriptions of the church...
 - 2. Remember that there is only one church no denominations...
- C. Christ and the church are one (Eph. 5:30).
- D. Thus, salvation in Christ is salvation in the church (cf. Acts 2:37-47; 4:12; John 14:6; Gal. 3:26-29).
