5. If the plague (scab) spread abroad in the skin, the person was pronounced what?
6. Was a bald man clean or unclean?
7. What four things was a leper to do?
8. While he had the plague of leprosy, where was he to dwell?
9. Where was the priest to go in order to inspect one who had been cleansed of leprosy?
10. What things were to be taken for one who was to be cleansed of leprosy?
11. After the cleansed leper was sprinkled with blood seven times, what was to be done to the living bird?
12. On the 7th day after having been cleansed of leprosy, what was the person to shave?
13. On the 8th day, the man who was to be cleansed was presented where?
14. What was done with the oil unto the person who was cleansed?
