Text: Numbers 6:22 - 10:10

|. The Blessing upon the People (Numbers 6:22-27)

- Note that the command for this blessing came from the Lord. А.
- B. It was the role of the priests to pronounce the blessings of God upon the people (cf. Lev. 9:22-23; Deut. 10:8; 21:5; Josh. 8:33; 1 Chron. 23:13).
 - 1. Relate this to the act of Jesus just before His ascension (Luke 24:50-51).
 - This demonstrates Jesus' role as High Priest (cf. Heb. 7:1, 7, 11-14). 2.
- C. This blessing directly ties into the promise made to Abraham (Gen. 12:1-3).
- D. There is a three-fold promise in this blessing from God.
 - The promise of protection (Psa. 121:4-7; cf. John 17:11; 1 Thes. 5:23; 1 Pet. 1:5)
 - The word for 'keep' means, "To hedge about; to guard." a.
 - God would protect them on their journey and in their new home. b.
 - 2. The promise of pardon (Exo. 33:19; cf. Heb. 2:9; 4:16; 1 Pet. 4:10)
 - Grace was necessary for their forgiveness of sins along the way. a.
 - God had made pardon possible and promised to grant it. b.
 - 3. The promise of <u>peace</u> (cf. Phil. 4:7; 2 Thes. 3:16)
 - God would give them peace along the journey and in the Promised Land. a.
 - More than that, they would be at peace with God! b.
- E. All of these were available because God looked upon them with love and approval (Psa. 4:6; 42:5; 80:1-3, 7, 19; cf. Isa. 59:1-2).
- F. Fellowship with God allowed them to receive blessings in the name of God.
- 11. The Gifts of the Princes of Israel
 - These gifts were free-will offerings made in addition to all that they had already given. А.
 - В. The purpose was to enable the priests to do the work of the Tabernacle.
 - C. Note carefully verse 9 - oxen and wagons were not given to the sons of Kohath, for they were to bear the furniture of the Tabernacle upon their shoulders (cf. 2 Sam. 6; 1 Chron. 15).
 - D. Note verse 89 - God spoke to Moses from the mercy seat, just as He had promised (cf. Exo. 25:22).
