"Behold Thy Mother!"

Text: John 19:23-27

Introduction:

- 1. Today is Mother's Day.
- 2. Mothers and Fathers are to be honored every day by one's life.
- 3. Lessons from Jesus' care for His mother.
- I. "Behold Thy Mother"
 - A. When Jesus was crucified, He remembered His mother.
 - 1. While He was on the cross, soldiers divided His garments.
 - 2. His coat (tunic) was without seam, so they gambled for it.
 - 3. According to tradition, this tunic was made for a Jewish man by his mother in preparation for his life apart from the home.
 - B. She had cared for and stood by Jesus all of His life.
 - 1. Luke 1:38 Responsibility
 - 2. Luke 2:19 Meditation, maturation
 3. Luke 2:22-24, 39 Spiritual upbringing
 - 4. Luke 2:34-35 Sacrifice
 - 5. Luke 2:40-52 *Discipline, nurturing (cf. Eph. 6:4)*
 - 6. John 2:3-5 Confidence 7. John 19:25 - Loyalty
 - C. Jesus obeyed the command to "honor thy father and thy mother."
 - 1. To honor one's parents is to feel the weight of respect for them (Col. 3:20; Eph. 6:1-3).
 - 2. To honor one's parents is to bear the weight of caring for them (Mark 7:10-13; 1 Tim. 5:1-4, 8, 16).
 - 3. To honor one's parents is to bestow upon them the obedience, respect, and love that they deserve.
 - D. Even in the midst of great suffering, Jesus remembered His mother.
- II. "Behold Thy Son"
 - A. Jesus provided for His mother by entrusting her care to John.
 - B. This demonstrates the great faith of John.
 - 1. Mary had other sons the half-brothers of Jesus (Matt. 13:55; Mark 6:3).
 - 2. However, they did not believe in Jesus (John 7:5).
 - 3. The spiritual bond surpassed any physical tie.
 - C. This illustrates the sterling character of John.
 - 1. Jesus knew that John was trustworthy, loyal, and faithful.
 - 2. Immediately, John took her as a part of his own family.
 - 3. Jesus has committed great responsibility to His disciples.
 - 4. Are we faithful stewards?
 - D. Even though they were not related by blood, Mary and John became mother and son to one another.
 - 1. Adoption
 - 2. Step-families
 - 3. Mentors (Mark 10:29-30; 1 Tim. 5:1-2; Titus 2:1-6)
 - E. Like Jesus, we must learn to honor our parents.
