- A. A second evidence for Paul's conversion is what he taught that all men must do in order to be saved.
- B. Hear Romans 1:16-17; 10:17

{*The Gospel is for all! Cf. Luke 24:25-27, 45-48*}

- C. Believe Romans 3:22; 5:1-2
- D. Repent Romans 2:4; Acts 17:30-31
- E. Confess Faith Romans 10:8-10
- F. Be Baptized Romans 6:1-7; Galatians 3:26-27

III. PAUL'S RECORDED OBEDIENCE

- A. Finally, there is the record of Paul's conversion which describes what he did in order to be saved.
- B. Heard Acts 9:3-6; 22:6-10
- C. Believed Acts 9:5, 17; 22:14
- D. Repented Acts 9:1-2, 9, 19-21
- E. Confessed Faith Acts 26:16-21 implied; 9:20, 22
- F. Was Baptized Acts 22:16; 9:17-19

Conclusion: Paul was saved in the same way that every Christian is saved.
