THE DANGER OF PASSIVITY

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. In our lives as Christians, we must be active whether standing and fighting against the enemy or developing and maturing as a child of God.
- 2. We must beware the danger of passivity.

I. IN TEMPTATION

- A. Example: *Adam* (Genesis 3:1-6)
 - 1. Adam was present at the temptation, for he was "with her."
 - 2. Adam was not deceived by the serpent (1 Tim. 2:14).
 - 3. Yet, he did nothing to stop his wife and willfully partook of the forbidden fruit himself.
- B. When tempted, we must be active.
 - 1. In preparation
 - a. Knowing it will come (1 Cor. 10:13)
 - b. Knowing from whence it comes (James 1:13, 17)
 - c. Knowing how it will come (1 John 2:15-16; Matt. 4:1-11)
 - d. Then, avoiding as much as we can
 - e. Yet, clothing ourselves with armor (Eph. 6:13ff)
 - 2. In faith (Ephesians 6:10; 1 John 4:4)
 - 3. In resistance (James 1:14-16; 4:7-10)
 - a. Prayer
 - b. Study
 - c. Fellowship
 - d. Fighting (Eph. 6:11-12; Lk. 13:24; 1 Cor. 9:24-27)
 - 4. In escape (1 Tim. 6:11; Gen. 39:7-12; 1 Cor. 10:13)
- C. In temptation, to be passive is to be defeated.

II. IN GROWTH

- A. Example: *Hebrew Christians* (Hebrews 5:11-14)
 - 1. The fault was their own, for they had become lazy.
 - a. The word "dull" means, "sluggish, slow, lazy, slothful."
 - b. They were lazy in their hearing; thus, they had not grown.
 - 2. They had been Christians long enough to be able to understand and teach others.
 - 3. They were malnourished for they were content to remain in their immaturity drinking milk instead of eating meat.
 - 4. They were unskilled in the word for they lacked experience in using it.
 - 5. They were weak for they failed to exercise spiritually (1 Tim. 4:7).
- B. The danger of passivity in growth is that we will drift away from truth and salvation (Hebrews 2:1-4; 12:5; Matthew 16:8-9; Mark 8:18).
- C. We must be active in acquiring Bible knowledge.
- D. We must be active in strengthening our faith.
- E. We must be active in developing Christian character.
