## The Flood

### How Was Noah Saved?

Text: Genesis 6:5-8

#### Introduction:

1. There are many powerful lessons from this story.
  2. One of the greatest is how God saved Noah and his family.

- I. Noah Was Saved by Grace (Genesis 6:8)
    - A. Grace is favor bestowed upon another.
    - B. Grace is available to all, but it must be accessed (Titus 2:11-12).
    - C. Today, we are saved by grace (Ephesians 2:5-8).
  - II. Noah Was Saved by Faith (Hebrews 11:7)
    - A. Noah trusted God completely – even concerning “things not seen.”
    - B. His faith was put into action by obeying God’s instructions.
    - C. Today, we are saved by faith (Romans 10:9-10; Hebrews 11:6).
  - III. Noah Was Saved by Mercy (Genesis 6:13-18)
    - A. God’s mercy provided a plan for Noah’s salvation.
    - B. God’s mercy caused Him to remember Noah (Genesis 8:1).
    - C. Today, we are saved by mercy (Ephesians 2:4-7; 1 Peter 1:3).
  - IV. Noah Was Saved by Obedience (Genesis 6:9)
    - A. Whatever God commanded, Noah accepted and obeyed.
    - B. He followed God’s instructions completely (Hebrews 11:7).
    - C. Today, we are saved by obedience (Romans 6:15-18; Acts 6:7).
  - V. Noah Was Saved by Righteousness (Ezekiel 14:14; 2 Peter 2:5)
    - A. Noah preached righteousness.
    - B. Noah’s obedience made him righteous.
    - C. Today, we are saved by righteousness (Romans 1:16-17).
  - VI. Noah Was Saved by Water (1 Peter 3:20)
    - A. The waters of the flood carried Noah into a new, pure world.
    - B. There was water in God’s plan.
    - C. Today, we are saved by water (1 Peter 3:20-21; Acts 8:35-38).

#### Conclusion:

1. The things that saved Noah are also the things that save us.
