PART 4 – THE HOLY SPIRIT AND PRAYER

Introduction:

- 1. "Lord, teach us to pray" (Luke 11:1).
- 2. Prayer must be a priority and according to God's pattern.
- 3. What role does God play in prayer?
- I. The Role of the Father in Prayer
 - A. As a Father, God promises to hear the prayers of His children (Luke 11:11-13).
 - B. God will answer our prayers with that which is best for us.
- II. The Role of the Son in Prayer
 - A. Prayer is offered in the name of (by the authority of) Jesus (John 16:23, 26-27).
 - B. Jesus is the one Mediator between God and man.
 - 1. Mediator one who acts between two parties and belongs to both; one who intervenes between two, in order to make or restore peace
 - 2. 1 Tim. 2:5; Heb. 2:16-18; 4:14-16; 5:7-9
 - C. Jesus is an Intercessor between God and man.
 - 1. Intercessor one who entreats or consults with one on behalf of another
 - 2. Hebrews 7:25; 1 John 2:1; Romans 8:34
 - 3. Anyone can be an intercessor (cf. Genesis 18:23-32; Exodus 32:7-14; etc.).
- III. The Role of the Holy Spirit in Prayer
 - A. The Holy Spirit is a person a member of the Godhead.
 - B. Every non-miraculous work attributed to the Holy Spirit is also said to be done by the Word, save one prayer.
 - C. The Holy Spirit is an Intercessor in our prayers.
 - 1. Romans 8:15-28
 - 2. Vs. 15-17 We are children of God
 - 3. Vs. 18-23 Yet, we live in a world of suffering
 - 4. Vs. 24-25 *We are saved by hope*
 - 5. Vs. 26-27 The Holy Spirit helps in our prayers
 - a. He bears our burdens before God's throne.
 - b. God knows "the mind of the Spirit."
 - c. Thus, our prayers are heard and our struggles are known.
 - 6. Vs. 28 All things work together for good
 - D. The Christian has two Intercessors with the Father ensuring our prayers are heard and in harmony with His will (cf. Revelation 5:8; 8:3-5).

Conclusion: Psalm 37:4-5

"Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart. Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring *it* to pass." (Psalm 37:4-5)
