PRAYER OF PRAISE

(James 1:17)

PRAISE GOD FOR HIS BOUNTIFUL BLESSINGS

"Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."

James 1:17

God is a God of blessing. Every good thing received by man is a gift from God. He is the source of all blessings and He longs to bless His children liberally without harshness (James 1:5). PRAY FOR THE PEACE OF THE CHURCH

3 John 1:9-10

The church will thrive only when it is a peace. Diotrephes brought conflict and chaos into the church. God desires His children to live, work, and worship together in peace and unity. Let us pray for the church – locally and worldwide. Pray that each congregation will have the peace needed to please God and to encourage one another. Pray that we will seek to bring peace to a world lost in sin.

PRAYER FOR OTHERS

(1 Peter 3:7)

PRAY FOR THE HOME

"Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honor unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered."

1 Peter 3:7

The home stands in need of prayer. It is constantly attacked by the forces of evil. One's home life affects his spiritual life. We need strong homes that believe and follow the Word of God. PRAYER FOR SPIRITUAL NEEDS

(2 Peter 3:10-12)

PRAY FOR GODLINESS

"Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness."

2 Peter 3:11

Godliness refers to reverence, respect, or piety toward God. One who is godly is devout, striving to be like God in thought, motive, and action. Godliness is found in the revelation of the Gospel (1 Tim. 3:16; 6:3; 2 Pet. 1:3). It is something to be worked toward and pursued (1 Tim. 4:7-8; 6:11). Let us pray for godliness.
