 - a. In the church (Acts 2:47; Hebrews 2:12).
 - b. Expressed in song (Acts 16:25; Hebrews 13:15).

 - A. The church is a foretaste of Heaven.
 - 1. In salvation... (1 Peter 1:6-9)
 - 2. In fellowship... (1 John 3:2-3; Revelation 21:1-3; 22:3-5)
