Judges 2:16-17

RESPECT FOR THINGS HOLY

Introduction:

- 1. In our study of the book of Judges, we have seen the difficulties of the nation of Israel.
- 2. Numerous times, they became unfaithful to the Lord and suffered severe consequences.
- 3. In order to avoid making the same mistakes they did, we need to understand the root cause of their sins.
- 4. Ultimately, in spite of all they had seen and all God had done for them, the children of Israel had a lack of respect for things that are holy (Leviticus 11:45; 22:31-33).
- I. Respect for God's Holy Word

(1:21, 27-33)

- A. In the first chapter, Israel is seen disobeying the Word of God by failing to drive out the inhabitants of the land.
- B. This may seem like a "small" or "insignificant" sin, but it led to terrible wrongs.
 - 1. Impurity
 - 2. Intermarriage
 - 3. Idolatry
- C. God's commands are holy (Rom. 1:2; 2 Tim. 3:15; 2 Pet. 1:21).
- D. Sadly, many still do not respect God's holy word.
 - 1. Divorce (Matthew 19:9)
 - 2. Women's role (1 Timothy 2:11-12)
 - 3. Salvation errors (Heb. 5:8-9; Mark 16:16; etc.)
- II. Respect for God's Holy Men

(2:16-17; 6:7-10)

- A. The judges were holy men because they were "raised up" by God to that position and for that purpose.
- B. However, the Israelites showed them little, if any, respect.
 - 1. They disobeyed the judges.
 - 2. They would not listen to the prophets.
- C. God still has holy men today.
 - 1. Elders (Acts 20:28; Titus 1:5-11; 1 Peter 5:1-3; Hebrews 13:17)
 - 2. Preachers (2 Timothy 4:1-4; Titus 1:13; 2:15; 1 Corinthians 9:16)
 - 3. In fact, all Christians are holy (1 Peter 2:9)!
- D. Sadly, many still do not respect God's holy men.
- III. Respect for God's Holy People

(3:1-7)

- A. The Israelites failed to respect their own purity as God's holy people.
- B. Sadly, many in the church do not respect their brethren as God's holy people.
 - 1. Love (John 13:34-35; 15:12; Romans 12:10; 1 Thes. 4:9; 1 Jn. 4:11)
 - 2. Unity (Ephesians 4:1-6; John 17:20-23; 1 Cor. 1:10; 12:12)
 - 3. Purity (Ephesians 5:25-27; 2 Cor. 11:2; Revelation 21:27)
- IV. Respect for God's Holy Plan

(4:8-9)

- A. The story of Deborah demonstrates the Israelites' rejection of God's order.
- B. Sadly, many continue to disrespect God's perfect, holy plan.
 - 1. In the home
 - 2. In the church
 - 3. In salvation

Judges 2:16-17

V. Respect for God's Holy Power

(7:1-3)

- A. When it was time to go to battle, 22,000 men of Israel were "fearful and afraid."
- B. They trusted in themselves and doubted God's power.
- C. Sadly, many still have no respect for the power of God.
 - 1. In the Gospel (Romans 1:16; 2 Timothy 1:7)
 - 2. In forgiveness (Matthew 9:6; Hebrews 7:25; 1 John 1:9)
 - 3. In temptation and trial (Matthew 6:13; 2 Corinthians 12:9; Eph. 6:10)
 - 4. In Judgment (Luke 12:5; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9)
- VI. Respect for God's Holy Authority

(9:1-6)

- A. Abimelech was so rebellious that he murdered his brethren and made himself a judge of Israel (cf. Matthew 21:23).
- B. Sadly, too many still have just as little respect for the authority of God.
 - 1. Where is the authority for instrumental music in NT worship?
 - 2. Where is the authority to partake of the Lord's Supper on Thursday?
 - 3. Where is the authority for a choir or drama group?
 - 4. Where is the authority for "Children's Church"?
 - 5. Where is the authority for a missionary or benevolence society?
- VII. Respect for God's Holy Morality

(14:1-3; 16:1; 19:22-30)

- A. Samson is just one example of the immorality of the Israelites.
- B. The men of Gibeah demonstrate just how far a people can fall when they disrespect God's standard.
- C. Sadly, many still rebel against God's holy standard of morality.
- VIII. Respect for God's Holy Worship

(17:1-13)

- Micah rejected God's pattern and established his own system of worship.
- B. God was displeased with Him and with all who practice vain worship (cf. Matthew 15:9; Mark 7:7).
- C. Sadly, many still have no respect for God's pattern for holy worship.
 - 1. Sing (Ephesians 5:19)
 - 2. Pray (1 Timothy 2:8)
 - 3. Preach (Acts 2:42; 20:7)
 - 4. Give (1 Corinthians 16:1-2)
 - 5. Lord's Supper (Acts 20:7)

Conclusion: Judges 21:25

- 1. We must not do what is "right in our own eyes."
- 2. Instead, we must respect things that are holy.
- 3. God's Word must be our standard in all that we say and do (Colossians 3:17).
- 4. Are you obedient to the Holy Scriptures?
