

Introduction:

- 2. These chapters record David's many victories against many enemies.
- 3. They reveal how the kingdom of Israel began to grow its territory to its greatest extent thus far.
- I. Various Victories
 - A. David defeated the Philistines, taking the city of Gath.
 - B. David defeated the Moabites, killing 2/3 of the soldiers (cf. 22:3-4).
 - C. David defeated Zobah, to the northeast of Damascus.
 - D. David defeated the Syrians of Damascus.
 - E. David was befriended by Toi, King of Hamath.
 - F. David subdued Edom.
