My Participation

Introduction:

- 1. The church is the blood bought body of Christ (Acts 20:28; Eph. 1:22-23).
- 2. As such, it exists in two forms universal and local.
- 3. While I am a member of the universal church of Christ, my service in the church is rendered on a local level under the local organization of the congregation.
- 4. Thus, because I am a member of the local church, there is much that I owe it.
- 5. I owe the local congregation my prompt presence.
- 6. I owe the local congregation my <u>participation</u>...
- I. I Owe the Church My Participation in Worship
 - A. Worship, as authorized by the New Testament, is congregational in nature.
 - 1. Singing (Heb. 2:12; Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16)
 - 2. Prayer (Acts 2:42; 4:31; 12:5, 12; 1 Tim. 2:8)
 - 3. Giving (1 Cor. 16:1-2; 2 Cor. 9:7)
 - 4. Preaching (Acts 20:7)
 - 5. Lord's Supper (Acts 2:42; 20:7; 1 Cor. 11:20)
 - B. The worship of the entire congregation is directed toward God.
 - 1. Singing (Rom. 15:9; Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16)
 - 2. Prayer (Matt. 6:6, 9; Luke 6:12; 1 Pet. 3:12)
 - 3. Giving (2 Cor. 8:5; 9:12)
 - 4. Preaching (Titus 1:3; Gal. 4:16; 2 Tim. 4:1-4)
 - 5. Lord's Supper (1 Cor. 11:23-25)
 - C. Yet, congregational worship also serves to benefit the participants.
 - 1. Singing (1 Cor. 14:15; Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16)
 - 2. Prayer (1 Cor. 14:15; Phil. 4:6-7; Jam. 5:16)
 - 3. Giving (Rom. 15:26; 2 Cor. 9:2)
 - 4. Preaching (1 Cor. 15:1; cf. Rom. 10:17
 - 5. Lord's Supper (1 Cor. 11:26)
 - D. If I do not participate in the worship service...
 - 1. I hinder the worship of the congregation (cf. Rev. 3:4).
 - 2. I do not express my worship, praise and thanksgiving to God.
 - 3. I prevent my brethren from being edified and encouraged.
- II. I Owe the Church My Participation in Work

Α.

- The divinely authorized work of the church is threefold...
 - 1. Edification (Acts 15:32; 1 Cor. 14:3-5, 26; Eph. 4:12, 16).
 - 2. Benevolence (Gal. 6:10; Titus 3:8; Heb. 13:16; 1 Jn. 3:17-18)
 - 3. Evangelism (Matt. 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16; etc.)
- B. If the work of the church is going to be done, the church must do it!
- C. In order for the church to work, **I must work!**
- D. I must participate in edification...
 - 1. By attending and participating in the worship services.

- 2. By attending and participating in Bible classes.
- 3. By involving myself in the teaching program.
- 4. By visiting, calling and/or writing the wayward, sick and shut-in.
- 5. By participating in opportunities of fellowship.
- E. I must participate in benevolence...
 - 1. By making others aware of opportunities to do good.
 - 2. By visiting, calling and/or writing the wayward, sick and shut-in.
 - 3. By supporting the benevolent efforts of the church.
- F. I must participate in evangelism... (See lesson five)

Conclusion:

- 1. I owe the local congregation my participation in its worship and work.
- 2. In fact, I cannot be pleasing to God unless I participate!
- 3. Where will this congregation be in 5, 10, 20 years if we do not give it our participation **now**?
