Introduction:

- 1. The church is the blood bought body of Christ (Acts 20:28; Eph. 1:22-23).
- 2. While I am a member of the universal church of Christ, my service in the church is rendered on a local level under the local organization of the congregation.
- 3. I owe the local congregation my prompt presence.
- 4. I owe the local congregation my participation.
- 5. I owe the local congregation my <u>pattern</u> and my <u>positive influence</u>.
- 6. I owe the local congregation my personal work...
- I. I Owe the Church My Personal Work as a Servant
  - A. Edifying the church.
  - B. Serving the suffering.
  - C. Evangelizing the lost (Luke 19:10).
- II. I Owe the Church My Personal Work as an Evangelist

## A. The Great Commission is Powerful

## (Matthew 28:18)

- 1. The one who commands it has all power (authority).
- 2. The command itself is powerful.
- 3. The message to be preached is powerful (Romans 1:16).
  - a. Only way for man to be saved (cf. 1 Cor. 1:21).
  - b. Emphasizes the importance of teaching God's Word alone.
- B. The Great Commission is Personal (Matthew 28:19a)
  - 1. "Go ye" means "go me." (Cf. Mark 16:15; John 20:21).
- 2. The Apostles preached that we must preach (Jude 1:3).
- C. The Great Commission is Practical (Matthew 28:19b)
  - 1. The goal is to make disciples of all.
  - 2. This is done by baptizing (preceded by teaching).
  - 3. This is done by teaching or educating.
  - 4. What do we teach?
    - a. A Crucified Savior (John 12:32; 1 Cor. 2:1-2; Rom. 5:6-10).
    - b. A Comforting Savior (Rom. 10:15; 5:1; Eph. 2:14-15).
    - c. A Commanding Savior (Heb. 5:9).
- D. The Great Commission is Perpetual (Matthew 28:20a)
  - 1. A three-fold charge...
    - a. Evangelize
    - b. Baptize
    - c. Immunize
  - 2. Those taught must then teach others (2 Tim. 2:2).
- E. The Great Commission is Providential (Matthew 28:20b)
  - 1. The immediate context is miraculously (cf. Mark 16:15-20).
  - 2. But God is still with us providentially...
    - a. In persecution (2 Corinthians 4:8-14).
    - b. In hardship (Hebrews 13:5-6).
    - c. In guidance (Acts 14:27; 1 Cor. 16:9; 2 Cor. 2:12; Col. 4:3).
