- I. I Owe the Church My Prayers
 - A. I should offer prayers of thanksgiving for the church.
 - 1. We should be thankful that the church exists.
 - 2. We should be thankful for the local congregation.
 - a. Rom. 1:8-9; Eph. 1:15-16; Phil. 1:4; Col. 1:3; 1 Thes. 1:2
 - b. In many places there is not a local church...
 - i. Influence in the community.
 - ii. Influence on moral issues.
 - iii. Influence on our children.
 - iv. Influence on our faith and faithfulness.
 - B. I should offer prayers of supplication for the church.
 - 1. We ought to pray for the church's health. (3 Jn. 1:2-3; 2 Ths. 1:3)
 - 2. We ought to pray for the church's influence. (1 Thes. 1:6-10; Phm. 1:5-7)
 - 3. We ought to pray for the church's growth. (Col. 4:3; 2 Ths. 3:1)
 - C. I should offer prayers of intercession for the church.
 - 1. We must pray for those who lead (Acts 14:23; 20:36).
 - 2. We must pray for those who suffer.
 - 3. We must pray for those who struggle.
 - 4. We must pray for those who return (Jam. 5:16; Acts 8:22-24).
- II. I Owe the Church My Patience
 - A. I must be patient with the leaders of the church.
 - 1. Rom. 2:4; 1 Pet. 3:20; 2 Pet. 3:9
 - 2. 2 Cor. 11:1-4
 - B. I must be patient with the members of the church.
 - 1. Romans 15:1
 - 2. 1 Cor. 3:2; 13:7; Gal. 5:22; Eph. 4:2; Col. 3:12-13
 - C. I must be patient with the work of the church.
