MARRIAGE IS HONORABLE IN ALL

Introduction:

- 1. In our world, there is much misunderstanding about marriage.
- 2. There is also much abuse of the institution of marriage.
- 3. Yet, the Bible declares that marriage is honorable.
- 4. Let us consider why...
- I. The Honor of Marriage
 - A. The word "honorable" means, "valuable, costly, esteemed or honored; as of great price, precious."
 - 1. It also is translated as "precious," "dear," and "reputation" (cf. Acts 5:34).
 - 2. It is used for our "precious" faith (1 Pet. 1:7).
 - 3. It is used for the "precious" blood of Christ (1:19).
 - 4. It is used for the "precious" promise of Heaven (2 Peter 1:4).
 - B. The ASV renders the verse this way: "Let marriage be had in honor among all, and let the bed be undefiled...."
 - 1. Thus, marriage is honorable in every way.
 - 2. And, it is to be honored by all people.
 - C. Why is marriage honorable, precious and of such value?
 - 1. It is ordained by God (Gen. 2:21-25; Mat. 19:6).
 - 2. It is a blessed arrangement for man (Genesis 2:18; Proverbs 18:22; Ruth 3:1).
 - 3. It is the perfect design for the home (Eph. 6:1-4).
- II. The Dishonoring of Marriage
 - A. In spite of what the Bible teaches, man continues to dishonor the sacred institution of marriage.
 - B. By living together out of wedlock (Hebrews 13:4)
 - C. By not being the husband one should be (1 Pet. 3:7)
 - 1. Permanence Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them
 - 2. Perception according to knowledge
 - 3. Praise *giving honor unto the wife*
 - 4. Protection as unto the weaker vessel
 - 5. Provision as unto the weaker vessel
 - 6. Promise and as being heirs together of the grace of life
 - 7. Prayer that your prayers be not hindered
 - D. By not being the wife one should be (1 Peter 3:1-6)
 - 1. Honor be in subjection to your own husbands
 - 2. Holiness *vour chaste conversation coupled with fear*
 - 3. Humility the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit
 - E. By separation and divorce (Mal. 2:16; Matt. 5:31-32)
 - F. By committing adultery (Matt. 5:27-28; 2 Pet. 2:12-14)
 - G. By perverting God's plan for marriage...
 - 1. Homosexual marriage (Rom. 1:26-27)
 - 2. Polygamous marriage (1 Corinthians 7:2)
 - 3. Marriage, divorce and remarriage (Matt. 19:1-9)
