- I. Her Example of Purity
  - A. Pure in conduct.
    - 1. She was sexually pure (Luke 1:27, 34; Matt. 1:18, 22-25).
    - 2. She was scripturally pure (Luke 1:46-55)
  - B. Pure in character.
    - 1. She was searching (Luke 1:26-34).
    - 2. She was submissive (Luke 1:38).
    - 3. She was serious (Luke 2:19).
- II. Her Example of Parenting
  - A. She taught sacrifice.
    - 1. To care for her Son (Luke 2:4-7).
    - 2. To protect her Son (Matt. 2:13-15, 19-23).
  - B. She taught submission.
    - 1. To the Law of God (Luke 2:21-24, 40-41).
    - 2. To the law of the family (Luke 2:42-52).
- III. Her Example of Perseverance
  - A. She evangelized (John 2:1-5, 11).
  - B. She empathized (Matt. 12:46-50; Mark 3:31-35; Luke 8:19-21).
  - C. She endured (John 19:25-27).
  - D. She exemplifies (Acts 1:14).
