## The Name of the Church

I. Man-made Names Are Sinful
A. Man-made denominations usually wear man-made names.

1. To honor their founder
2. To highlight their doctrine
3. To designate a day
4. To describe their organization
B. Man-made names are condemned in Scripture (1 Corinthians 1:10-17).
C. Man-made names cause division (cf. John 17).
D. Man-made names substitute the name of Jesus (cf. Acts 4:12).
E. Man-made names create confusion and unbelief (cf. 1 Corinthians 14:33).
F. Man-made names cause souls to be lost.
II. No Exclusive Name Is Given in Scripture
A. The Bible gives several different designations that are applied to the church.

7. The church of God Acts 20:28; 1 Cor. 1:2; 10:32; 11:16, 22

10. The house of God $\quad 1$ Timothy 3:15
11. The church of the firstborn Hebrews 12:23
12. The body Ephesians 5:23

15. The kingdom of God Acts 8:12; 19:8; 20:25; 28:23, 31
16. The kingdom of God's Son Colossians 1:13
17. God's husbandry (farm, field) 1 Corinthians $3: 9$
18. God's building $\quad 1$ Corinthians 3:9
19. The flock 1 Peter 5:3
B. However, each of these names gives honor to God and Jesus - not to man.
III. The Church Should Wear the Name of Jesus
A. Jesus built the church (Matthew 16:18).
B. Jesus purchased (Acts 20:28).
C. Jesus saves it (Ephesians 5:23).
D. Jesus guides it (Colossians $1: 18$ ).
E. Thus, the name "church of Christ" is both honorable and scriptural (Rom. 16:16).
IV. Members of the Church Wear the Name of Jesus
A. God promised a new name (Isaiah 62:2).
B. $\quad$ The name "Christian" was given by God in Antioch (Acts 11:26; cf. 26:28; 1 Pet. 4:16).
C. True disciples are Christians only!
