- I. Anointing of Holiness
 - A. The shepherd anointed the sheep of his flock because they belonged to him and were under his care.
 - B. The priests were separated for the service of the Tabernacle, their anointing a sign of their belonging to God (Exodus 28:35-41).
 - C. This anointing is refreshing, producing unity (Psalm 133).
 - D. All Christians are priests, holy unto God (1 Peter 2:5-9).

 - A. Nose worms / Worry, doubt, fear (1 Pet. 5:7; Phil. 4)
 - B. Wounds / Sin, guilt (Heb. 9:14; 10:22; 1 Pet. 3:21)
 - C. Headbutts / Conflict (Eph. 4:1-6)
- III. Anointing of Heirs
 - A. David anointed as King (1 Samuel 16:12-13)
 - B. Christians reign with Christ (Rev. 5:10; 22:5)
