FUNDAMENTAL FACTS

Introduction:

- 1. The word "church" comes from the Greek word *ecclesia* (εκκλησια) which means, "those who are called out of" or "those who are summoned."
- 2. An effective way to learn the meaning of a biblical word or concept is to observe how it is used throughout Scripture.
- I. The Church Is Built by Jesus

(Matthew 16: 18)

- A. Jesus said, "I will build my church."
- B. This teaches us that the church is built by Christ.
 - 1. He is the architect of the church (Hebrews 3: 3-4).
 - 2. He was prophesied to be the builder of the church (Zech. 6: 12-13).
 - 3. Thus, the church is God's building (1 Cor. 3: 9).
- II. The Church Is Built upon Jesus

(Matthew 16: 18)

- A. Jesus said, "Upon this rock I will build my church."
- B. The "rock" Jesus mentions is the fact of His own divine nature.
 - 1. Peter had just confessed the deity of Jesus (vs. 16).
 - 2. This fact is the basis of salvation (John 8: 24).
- C. Jesus is the foundation of the church!
 - 1. He was prophesied so to be (Isa. 28: 16; Psalm 118: 22-23).
 - 2. Jesus applied that prophecy to Himself (Matt. 21: 42-44).
 - 3. The apostles taught it (Acts 4:11-12; Rom. 9: 32-33; 1 Cor. 3:11; 1 Pet. 2:4-8).
- III. The Church Is the Kingdom of Jesus

(Matthew 16: 19)

- A. Jesus said, "I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven."
- B. Thus, the church and the kingdom are the same institution.
 - 1. There were people in the kingdom of Christ in the first century (Col. 1:13; 4:11; 1 Thes. 2:12; 2 Thes. 1:5; Heb. 12:28; Rev. 1:9).
 - 2. The kingdom came into existence with power on the day of Pentecost (Mark 9:1; Luke 24:49; Ac. 1:4-8; 2:1-4).
- IV. The Church Is Guided by the Doctrine of Jesus (Matthew 16: 19)
 - A. Jesus said, "Whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven..."
 - B. Literally, Jesus said, "Whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall have already been bound in heaven."
 - C. Jesus doctrine would be revealed to and taught by His apostles.
 - 1. This promise was not given to Peter alone (Matt. 18: 18; John 20: 23).
 - 2. The Holy Spirit would guide them in this work (John 14: 16-17, 26; 15: 26-27; 16: 13-15).
 - D. By teaching the doctrine of Christ they were teaching the authoritative law for the church.
 - 1. It is called the doctrine of Christ (2 John 9-11).
 - 2. It is called the apostles' doctrine (Acts 2: 42).
 - 3. It is the law for Christ's church (Eph. 2:19-22).
- V. The Church Will Overcome Death

(Matthew 16: 18)

- A. Jesus said, "The gates of hell shall not prevail against it."
- B. Death will not have victory over the church of Christ! (Cf. Acts 2: 24, 31; 1 Cor. 15: 3-4, 20, 22-26, 53-57; Daniel 2: 44; 7: 14; Luke 1: 33; Hebrews 12: 28)
