# Beatitudes What The Bible Teaches About Being Blessed

# BLESSED IS THE MAN WHO DWELLS IN GOD'S HOUSE

Text: Psalm 84:1-4

- I. Love for God's House (vs. 1-2)
  - B. The House of God is the place where God dwells and, thus, where He is worshipped.
    - 1. Genesis 28:11-18
    - 2. Luke 2:49 (ASV) "And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? knew ye not that I must be in my Father's house?"
    - 3. Tabernacle Temple Church (Exo. 40:34-35; 1 Kin. 8:10-11)
  - C. Today the House of God is none other than the Church of Christ (1 Timothy 3:15; Hebrews 3:4-6; 1 Corinthians 3:16-17).
  - D. The blessed man will love God's House.
    - 1. Because of its holiness (Eph. 2:19-22).
    - 2. Because of its glory!
      - a. Before Christ, all came short of God's glory (Rom. 3:23).
      - b. It was prophesied that glory would come (1 Pet. 1:9-11).
      - c. That glory is in the church (Eph. 3:21).
      - d. The church reveals God's infinite wisdom, love, and work in the scheme of redemption (Eph. 3:10-11).
      - e. In the church, we can let our lights shine and allow others to glorify God (Matt. 5:16).
  - E. The blessed man will defend God's House.
    - 1. He will fight enemies from without (Col. 2:8-9; etc.).
    - 2. He will fight enemies from within (Jude 3; 2 Jn. 9-11; etc.).
    - 3. He will fight to extend the kingdom of Christ (Matt. 28:18-20).
- II. Safety in God's House (vs. 3)
  - A. The House of God is a place of safety for man, just as a nest is home for the birds of the air.
  - B. The illustration here is that the birds had access to the very House of God which the psalmist desired!
  - C. There is safety and security in the presence of God!
    - 1. Never thirst (John 4:14).
    - 2. Never hunger (John 6:35).
    - 3. Never perish (John 10:27-29).
    - 4. Never die (John 11:25-26).
    - 5. Never alone (Hebrews 13:5).
    - 6. Never fall (1 Peter 1:10-11).
  - D. There is safety and security in the church!
    - 1. We can know the Truth (1 John 2:20-21).
    - 2. We can know error (1 John 4:5-6).
    - 3. We can know obedience (1 John 2:28-29; 3:6-8).

- 4. We can know the Savior (1 John 3:5; 2:3-5).
- 5. We can know divine fellowship (1 John 1:3; 3:24-4:3).
- 6. We can know salvation (1 John 3:14-15, 18-22).
- 7. We can know the light (1 John 1:6-9; 5:18-21).
- 8. We can know love (1 John 4:7-13, 16-5:5).
- 9. We can know answered prayer (1 John 5:14-15).
- 10. We can know eternal life (1 John 5:13; 3:2).

### III. Devotion to God's House (vs. 4, 10)

- A. The blessed man will dwell in God's House.
  - 1. He will not come and go in and out but will remain faithfully dedicated to the Lord's church.
  - 2. He will not "quit the church," but be faithful unto death (Rev. 2:10).
- B. The blessed man longs and loves to worship God in His House.
  - 1. It is only in God's House that He can be worshipped acceptably (Ephesians 3:21; Hebrews 2:12).
  - 2. Thus, he will not forsake the assembly of the saints to worship the Almighty (Hebrews 10:25).
  - 3. Furthermore, he will look forward to, prepare for, and take part in the worship of God!
- C. The blessed man is willing to serve in the House of God.
  - 1. He serves by helping to lead in the worship service.
  - 2. He serves by teaching in the Bible classes.
  - 3. He serves by welcoming and visiting with visitors.
  - 4. He serves by physical labor around the grounds.
  - 5. He serves by taking part in occasions of fellowship.
  - 6. He serves by praying for the church.
  - 7. He serves by living the Christian life as an example before others.
  - 8. He serves by visiting the sick and less fortunate.
  - 9. He serves by evangelizing.
  - 10. He serves by growing in his own faith and trust in Christ.
- D. Thus, the blessed man is filled with devotion to God's House.

#### Conclusion:

- 1. God's House is the most glorious institution on earth.
- 2. To be a child of God, dwelling in His House, is a blessing that should never be taken for granted.
- 3. When truly we understand the greatness of the church, we will love it as never before.
- 4. When finally we grasp the nature of the church, we will be secure and at peace as never before.
- 5. When we learn to appreciate the church of Christ, we will be devoted to it as never before.
