Beatitudes What The Bible Teaches About Being Blessed

BLESSED IS THE MAN WHOM THE LORD CHASTENS

Text: Psalm 94:12-14

Introduction:

- 1. "Where the word *blessed* is hung out as a sign, we may be sure that we shall find a godly man within." *Sir Richard Baker*
- 2. Biblically, the word "blessed" refers to those whose sufficiency comes from God and not from the circumstances of life.
- 3. The "blessed" are those who inherit the promise made to Abraham by conforming to God's Will and being added to the body of Christ.
- 4. This psalm teaches the blessedness of being corrected and disciplined by God.

I. The Means of Discipline

- A. The Hebrew word translated "chasten" in this verse means, "to *chastise*, literally (with blows) or figuratively (with words); hence to *instruct*" (Strong's).
 - 1. Brown, Driver, and Briggs' dictionary defines it: "to chasten, discipline, instruct, admonish."
 - 2. It is translated by the words "chastise," "correct," "instruct," "punish," "reformed," and "reproveth."
- B. It is clear that God does the correcting of His people, but how?
 - 1. By His Word...
 - a. His Word corrects (2 Timothy 3:16-17; 4:2).
 - b. His Word chastens (Revelation 3:19, 22).
 - 2. By a properly trained conscience...
 - a. The conscience convicts (John 8:9).
 - b. The conscience corrects (1 Peter 3:21).
 - 3. By the consequences of sin... (cf. Romans 6:23)
 - 4. By allowing hardship and trial...
 - a. Jeremiah 30:11
 - b. James 1:12
- C. We must be willing to humble ourselves before the chastisement of Jehovah.

II. The Reasons for Discipline

- A. God disciplines His children because He loves them.
 - 1. Deuteronomy 8:1-6; Proverbs 3:11-12
 - 2. Hebrews 12:5-13
- B. God disciplines His children to teach them.
 - 1. Psalm 119:67, 71
 - 2. 2 Chronicles 33:9-13
- C. God disciplines His children to save them.
 - 1. Proverbs 15:31-33
 - 2. 1 Corinthians 11:27-32

III. The Blessings of Discipline

A. Correction - God puts us back on the right path.
B. Fellowship - God treats us as a Father would a child.
C. Rest - We will be spared punishment (Psalm 94:13).
D. Salvation - God will forgive our errors and sins (Revelation 3:20).
E. Victory - God will give us eternal life in Heaven (Revelation 3:21).

Conclusion: "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches" (Revelation 3:22).
